


## The Glanusk Park Permitted Footpath

Welcome to the Glanusk Estate. Please enjoy your walk through The Park and the many fascinating historical and ecological features which are a part of it. These include many different species of oak, the beautiful Usk River and the unique parkland.

Whilst we wish you to enjoy your time in this special environment, we must stress that it is a working estate and so you must keep to the footpath. It should be noted that it is a footpath and as such the following are not permitted:

- Swimming or otherwise disturbing the river and fishing
- Bicycles
- Horses
- Motorised Vehicles
- Picnics
- Fires



The route of the Glanusk Park Permitted Footpath is identified with a dashed red line above and on site by way marking disks. Users must not stray from the route of the footpath.

## **Terms of Use**

- The permitted footpath is only to be used in daylight hours
- The landowner accepts no liability for the use of the permitted footpath.
- Parts of the permitted footpath may be closed from time to time for Estate Management purposes and during events in the Park. It does not permit access to events in the Park.
- All gates must be closed and all litter taken home with you.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- Care must be taken when using the permitted footpath along the river.

  Please note this part of the permitted footpath is not passable following heavy rain as the area is liable to flooding.
